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## CHCPRT001 Identify and respond to children and young people at risk

*Do you work with children or young people? Need child protection training?*

The CHCPRT001 Identify and respond to children and young people at risk (Child Protection) unit, describes the skills and knowledge required to support and protect children and young people who are at risk of harm. This unit applies to workers in a range of job roles providing services to children and young people including in community services and health contexts.

This training relates to the National Quality Standard (NQS) Quality Area 2 – promoting children’s health and safety.

Assessment is carried out in accordance with Commonwealth and State/Territory legislation, Australian/New Zealand standards and industry codes of practice.

- Organisation standards, policies and procedures
